RULES AND REGULATIONS WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP

- Each entrant in this tournament must be a female, and members of the USBC and Greater Harrisburg USBC (GHUSBC). Those who are not in possession of a USBC card must file an affidavit of membership or purchase an affiliate membership for \$20.00. Those who are USBC members and wish to join the GHUSBC may purchase an associate membership for \$7.00.
- All entries and competition in this tournament must be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) and the Greater Harrisburg USBC (GHUSBC).
- 3. Bowlers must be at least 16 years of age at time of participation. Unmarried grade school and high school students under the age of 18 must have written consent of a parent or guardian before participation. The USBC Parental consent form must be on file with tournament management at least one week before participation when the youth is unaccompanied by a parent or guardian. If the youth is accompanied by her parent or guardian, the consent form must be submitted prior to participation. Failure to file the consent form will cause the player to be ineligible and subject games bowled to disqualification. Form is available on bowl.com.
- Bowlers may compete MULTIPLE times in any of the events. In the Doubles event, not more than one (1) bowler on the same team can place more than once in the prize list. In Singles and All-Events, the bowler may only place one time.
- 5. AVERAGES (Please read carefully!): Entrants shall use their highest USBC previous season's (2019-2020) winter league average, 21 games or more. If no winter league average, entrant shall use highest 2020 USBC summer league average, 21 games or more. If no winter or summer league average for the previous season, entrant shall use highest 2020-2021 USBC winter season average as of March 20, 2021, based on 21 games or more. ALL OTHERS MUST BOWL SCRATCH. Entrants that have both a USBC Sport League Average and a standard league average from the same season shall use the higher of the two averages (adjusted). Any entrant who has only a USBC sport average must submit and use the adjusted Sport Bowling league average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale. The scale can be found on bowl.com.
- All participants are cautioned to be familiar with USBC e 319A (ten-pin rule), USBC Rule 319C (average adjustment), USBC Rule 319D (reporting of prize winnings) and USBC Rule 319E (average adjustment). These USBC rules are in effect for this tournament.
- 7. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in this tournament, whether originally submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. WRITTEN permission by tournament management may be given prior to completion of the first game of a series to a bowler requesting permission to correct their average within 48 hours.
- Bowlers wanting to apply for relief of average due to injury or disability under provisions of USBC Rule 4e must apply a minimum of 14 days prior to bowling. Please see USBC Playing Rules for information regarding Rule 4e.
- All participants are subject to re-rate and should familiarize themselves with USBC rues 319C and 319E
- Substitutes may be used when necessary as long as each substitute meets all rules of eligibility. Substitute must bowl in same position as original bowler.

- 11. Doubles shall bowl in order as submitted on original entry application. Substitution shall be made at least 30 minutes prior to the time scheduled to bowl. This is also the deadline for the doubles captain to report their presence to tournament management, unless a walk-in, which is governed by Rule 16. Doubles/singles may have the privilege of bowling on the same pair with another specified team as long as both applications are submitted together with a request to be paired together.
- Handicaps are computed on the three-game series for each event, and shall be based on 100% of the difference between entering average and 660 (Singles), 1320 (Doubles) and 1320 (All-Events) scratch scores.
- Improper conduct during the course of your competition may be cause for disqualification of scores in that event
- No practice on any scheduled tournament lanes are allowed on that team's scheduled day.
- 15. PRIZE FEES shall be paid 100% in cash prizes.
- Prize fees shall be divided in all divisions as follows: Handicap, approximately 60%, Scratch, approximately 40%.
- DIVISION STRUCTURE: The tournament will be comprised of two divisions as shown on the following chart:

- 18. REGISTRATION CLOSES 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO STARTING TIME OF THE SQUAD. Walk-ins may participate in the tournament provided there are lanes available for competition, and that said walk-ins have registered 30 minutes prior to the starting time of the squad. Entry fees must be paid in full prior to competing in each event.
- PRIZE RATIO shall be approximately 1 prize for every 5 entries in each division within each of the events.
- Failure to comply with above rules shall result in a disqualification of scores.
- 21. There will be a \$50.00 charge for returned checks!!!
- Funds Breakdown per bowler is as follows: Team and Minor Events, Bowling \$11.50, Prize Fund \$11.50, Administrative Costs, \$2.00. All-Events, Prize Fund \$5.00.
- 23. LATE FEE. All entries must be completely filled out and submitted at least 24 hours prior to bowling. This can be a paper entry or emailed to the address below (No PM's/texts will be accepted). All others will be charged a \$3.00 fee per Team, Doubles and Singles entry, \$1.00 for All Events.
- NO REFUNDS. Emergencies will be handled on a case by case basis.
